

MONTHLY FULL REPORT ON MANUFACTURERS' SHIPMENTS, INVENTORIES AND ORDERS APRIL 2017

Release Number: CB 17-74 M3-2 (17)-04

June 5, 2017 — The U.S. Census Bureau announces the April full report on manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders:





Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in April, down following four consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.2 percent to \$469.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.0 percent March increase. Shipments, up four of the last five months, increased \$0.1 billion or virtually unchanged to \$470.8 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent March decrease. Unfilled orders, up two consecutive months, increased \$2.4 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,123.0 billion. This followed a 0.3 percent March increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.84, up from 6.81 in March. Inventories, up six consecutive months, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.1 percent to \$649.7 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent March increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.38, unchanged from March.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in April, down following four consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$1.8 billion or 0.8 percent to \$231.0 billion, down from the previously published 0.7 percent decrease. This followed a 2.4 percent March increase. Transportation equipment, down following two consecutive monthly increases, led the decrease, \$1.1 billion or 1.4 percent to \$78.4 billion. New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$1.0 billion or 0.4 percent to \$238.0 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in April, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$232.8 billion, down from the previously published 0.3 percent decrease. This followed a 0.1 percent March decrease. Transportation equipment, down six of the last seven months, led the decrease, \$0.5 billion or 0.7 percent to \$77.1 billion. Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up eight of the last nine months, increased \$1.0 billion or 0.4 percent to \$238.0 billion. This followed a 0.3 percent March decrease. Food products, up seven of the last eight months, led the increase, \$0.8 billion or 1.1 percent to \$68.3 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in April, up two consecutive months, increased \$2.4 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,123.0 billion, virtually unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 0.3 percent March increase. Transportation equipment, also up two consecutive months, led the increase, \$1.4 billion or 0.2 percent to \$766.7 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in April, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$0.7 billion or 0.2 percent to \$394.6 billion, up from the previously published 0.1 percent increase. This followed a 0.3 percent March increase. Primary metals, also up nine of the last ten months, led the increase, \$0.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$32.7 billion. Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, down two consecutive months, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$255.1 billion. This followed a virtually unchanged March decrease. Beverage and tobacco products, also down two consecutive months, led the decrease, \$0.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$23.5 billion. By stage of fabrication, April materials and supplies increased 0.8 percent in durable goods and increased 0.7 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 0.5 percent in durable goods and increased 0.4 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.4 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.8 percent in nondurable goods.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing.

"Virtually unchanged" indicates that the change is less than 0.05 percent for a percent increase or decrease.

Description of the survey

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 5,000 reporting units that represent approximately 3,100 companies and provide an indication of month-to-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-tomonth changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the monthto-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 64 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census, and these companies include almost two-thirds of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2012 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 57 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication. 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Benchmark notice

Revised historical data from the Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) Survey were issued on May 18, 2017. These revisions result from:

- benchmarking the M3 shipments and inventories data to the 2015 Annual Survey of Manufactures (ASM) and revised 2014 ASM data on a 2012 NAICS basis;
- incorporating the unfilled orders to shipments ratios obtained from the 2015/2014 Manufacturers' Unfilled Orders (M3UFO) Survey by applying these ratios to the respective ASM shipments data, as well as incorporating revised unfilled orders to shipments ratios for prior years by applying them to the respective ASM data;
- adjusting the new orders data to be consistent with the benchmarked shipments and unfilled orders data;
- correcting monthly data for late receipts, reclassifications of reported data, and revisions to previously reported data;
- updating the seasonally adjusted data based on the results of benchmarking and the recent annual review of the seasonal adjustment models.

These revisions spanned the seasonally adjusted data for January 2002 through March 2017 and the data not seasonally adjusted for January 2007 through March 2017. Not seasonally adjusted estimates of shipments and new orders include adjusted data for non-calendar reporters. Seasonally adjusted estimates include concurrent adjustments for holiday and trading-day differences, where appropriate, as well as seasonal variation, based on the results of the latest annual review of the model parameters. Estimates are not adjusted for price changes.

2 Estimates and percent changes of shipments for the semiconductor industry are included in computers and electronic products, and all other applicable aggregate totals.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated.
