

MONTHLY FULL REPORT ON MANUFACTURERS' SHIPMENTS, INVENTORIES AND ORDERS FEBRUARY 2022

Release Number: CB 22-55 M3-2 (22)-02

April 4, 2022 — The U.S. Census Bureau announces the February full report on manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders:





Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in February, down following nine consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$2.7 billion or 0.5 percent to \$542.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.5 percent January increase. Shipments, up twenty-one of the last twenty-two months, increased \$3.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$541.0 billion. This followed a 1.4 percent January increase. Unfilled orders, up thirteen consecutive months, increased \$5.4 billion or 0.4 percent to \$1,288.5 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent January increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.74, up from 6.72 in January. Inventories, up twenty of the last twenty-one months, increased \$5.0 billion or 0.6 percent to \$785.2 billion. This followed a 0.8 percent January increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.45, unchanged from January.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in February, down following four consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$5.8 billion or 2.1 percent to \$271.7 billion, up from the previously published 2.2 percent decrease. This followed a 1.5 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, down following three consecutive monthly increases, led the decrease, \$4.6 billion or 5.3 percent to \$82.8

billion. New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$3.1 billion or 1.2 percent to \$270.3 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in February, up nine of the last ten months, increased less than \$0.1 billion or virtually unchanged to \$270.7 billion, up from the previously published virtually unchanged decrease. This followed a 1.2 percent January increase. Computers and electronic products, up seven of the last eight months, drove the increase, \$0.4 billion or 1.2 percent to \$30.3 billion. Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up twenty-one of the last twenty-two months, increased \$3.1 billion or 1.2 percent to \$270.3 billion. This followed a 1.5 percent January increase. Petroleum and coal products, up nine of the last ten months, led the increase, \$2.4 billion or 4.1 percent to \$61.5 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in February, up thirteen consecutive months, increased \$5.4 billion or 0.4 percent to \$1,288.5 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 0.9 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, up twelve of the last thirteen months, led the increase, \$5.0 billion or 0.6 percent to \$853.4 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in February, up thirteen consecutive months, increased \$2.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$479.1 billion, up from the previously published 0.4 percent increase. This followed a 0.5 percent January increase. Machinery, up sixteen consecutive months, led the increase, \$0.8 billion or 1.0 percent to \$80.5 billion. Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up sixteen of the last seventeen months, increased \$2.8 billion or 0.9 percent to \$306.2 billion. This followed a 1.2 percent January increase. Petroleum and coal products, up nine of the last ten months, led the increase, \$1.7 billion or 3.7 percent to \$48.1 billion. By stage of fabrication, February materials and supplies increased 1.0 percent in durable goods and 0.1 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.3 percent in durable goods and 2.1 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.1 percent in durable goods and 1.0 percent in nondurable goods.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing.

"Virtually unchanged" indicates that the change is less than 0.05 percent for a percent increase or decrease.

Description of the survey

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-inprocess, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 5,000 reporting units that represent approximately 3,100 companies and provide an indication of monthto-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 60 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2017 Economic Census, and these companies include roughly 61 percent of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2017 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 51 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2017 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication. Special Notice - New Advance Estimates Of Total Manufacturing

Beginning with September 2021 data released on October 27, 2021, advance estimates of total manufacturing, including M3 durable and nondurable industries, for shipments and inventories, are available at the same time as the Advance Report on Durable Goods Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders. Monthly advance total manufacturing estimates are available on a seasonally adjusted basis as well as a not seasonally adjusted basis on the M3 website under the "Advance Report Highlights".

Benchmark notice

Revised historical data from the Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) Survey will be issued on May 13, 2022. These revisions result from

- Benchmarking the M3 shipments and inventories data to the 2020 and 2019 Annual Survey of Manufactures (ASM) data;
- Incorporating the unfilled orders-to-shipments ratios obtained for 2020, 2019, and 2018 from the Manufacturers' Unfilled Orders (M3UFO) Survey;
- Adjusting the new orders data to be consistent with the benchmarked shipments and unfilled orders data;
- Correcting monthly data for late receipts, reclassifications of reported data, and revisions to previously reported data;
- Updating the seasonally adjusted data based on the results of benchmarking and the recent annual review of the seasonal adjustment models.

These revisions will span the seasonally adjusted data for January 2012 through March 2022 and the data not seasonally adjusted for January 2017 through March 2022. An updated Press Release will contain revised monthly tables for January 2022 through March 2022.
