

Highlights

U.S. crude oil refinery inputs averaged 17.2 million barrels per day during the week ending August 7, 2026, which was 26 thousand barrels per day more than the previous week's average. Refineries operated at 96.2% of their operable capacity last week. Gasoline production decreased last week, averaging 9.6 million barrels per day. Distillate fuel production increased, averaging 5.3 million barrels per day.

U.S. crude oil imports averaged 7.3 million barrels per day last week, increased by 1.14 million barrels per day from the previous week. Over the past four weeks, crude oil imports averaged about 6.3 million barrels per day, 0.1% more than the same four-week period last year. Total motor gasoline imports (including both finished gasoline and gasoline blending components) last week averaged 583 thousand barrels per day, and distillate fuel imports averaged 111 thousand barrels per day.

U.S. commercial crude oil inventories (excluding those in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve) increased by 17.4 million barrels from the previous week. At 424.4 million barrels, U.S. crude oil inventories are about 2% below the five-year average for this time of year. Total motor gasoline inventories decreased by 1.0 million barrels last week and are 6% below the five-year average for this time of year. Both finished gasoline and blending component inventories decreased last week. Distillate fuel inventories decreased by 0.1 million barrels last week and are about 12% below the five-year average for this time of year. Propane/propylene inventories increased by 1.9 million barrels from last week and are 31% above the five-year average for this time

of year. Total commercial petroleum inventories increased by 15.7 million barrels last week.

Total products supplied over the last four-week period averaged 20.7 million barrels per day, down by 2.1% from the same period last year. Over the past four weeks, motor gasoline product supplied averaged 9.0 million barrels per day, down by 0.5% from the same period last year. Distillate fuel product supplied averaged 3.7 million barrels per day over the past four weeks, up by 1.9% from the same period last year. Jet fuel product supplied was up 3.8% compared with the same four-week period last year.

The price for West Texas Intermediate crude oil was \$79.77 per barrel on August 7, 2026, \$6.39 less than a week ago, and \$14.83 more than a year ago. The New York Harbor spot price for conventional gasoline was \$2.970 per gallon, \$0.256 less than a week ago, and \$0.888 more than the year-ago price. The spot price for No. 2 heating oil at New York Harbor was \$3.775 per gallon, \$0.251 less than a week ago, and \$1.602 more than the price last year. The national average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$4.006 per gallon on August 10, 2026, \$0.073 less than last week's price, and \$0.888 more than the year-ago price. The national average retail diesel fuel price decreased \$0.091 to \$5.257 per gallon, \$1.503 more than the price one year ago.
