

Highlights

U.S. crude oil refinery inputs averaged 17.0 million barrels per day during the week ending June 5, 2026, which was 80 thousand barrels per day more than the previous week's average. Refineries operated at 95.3% of their operable capacity last week. Gasoline production increased last week, averaging 9.7 million barrels per day. Distillate fuel production increased, averaging 5.2 million barrels per day.

U.S. crude oil imports averaged 5.9 million barrels per day last week, decreased by 0.5 million barrels per day from the previous week. Over the past four weeks, crude oil imports averaged about 5.9 million barrels per day, 5.8% less than the same four-week period last year. Total motor gasoline imports (including both finished gasoline and gasoline blending components) last week averaged 714 thousand barrels per day, and distillate fuel imports averaged 130 thousand barrels per day.

U.S. commercial crude oil inventories (excluding those in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve) decreased by 7.2 million barrels from the previous week. At 426.5 million barrels, U.S. crude oil inventories are about 5% below the five-year average for this time of year. Total motor gasoline inventories increased by 0.2 million barrels from last week and are 6% below the five-year average for this time of year. Finished gasoline inventories increased, while blending component inventories decreased last week. Distillate fuel inventories decreased by 0.2 million barrels last week and are about 13% below the five-year average for this time of year. Propane/propylene inventories increased by 1.1 million barrels from last week and are 35%

above the five-year average for this time of year. Total commercial petroleum inventories decreased by 5.6 million barrels last week.

Total products supplied over the last four-week period averaged 20.6 million barrels per day, up by 3.5% from the same period last year. Over the past four weeks, motor gasoline product supplied averaged 8.8 million barrels per day, down by 0.5% from the same period last year. Distillate fuel product supplied averaged 3.7 million barrels per day over the past four weeks, up by 7.2% from the same period last year. Jet fuel product supplied was down 2.2% compared with the same four-week period last year.

The price for West Texas Intermediate crude oil was \$94.32 per barrel on June 5, 2026, \$3.16 more than a week ago, and \$29.02 more than a year ago. The New York Harbor spot price for conventional gasoline was \$3.130 per gallon, \$0.064 less than a week ago, and \$1.20 more than the year-ago price. The spot price for No. 2 heating oil at New York Harbor was \$3.507 per gallon, \$0.072 more than a week ago, and \$1.475 more than the price last year.

The national average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$4.146 per gallon on June 8, 2026, \$0.159 less than last week's price, and \$1.038 more than the year-ago price. The national average retail diesel fuel price decreased \$0.140 to \$5.210 per gallon, \$1.739 more than the price one year ago.
