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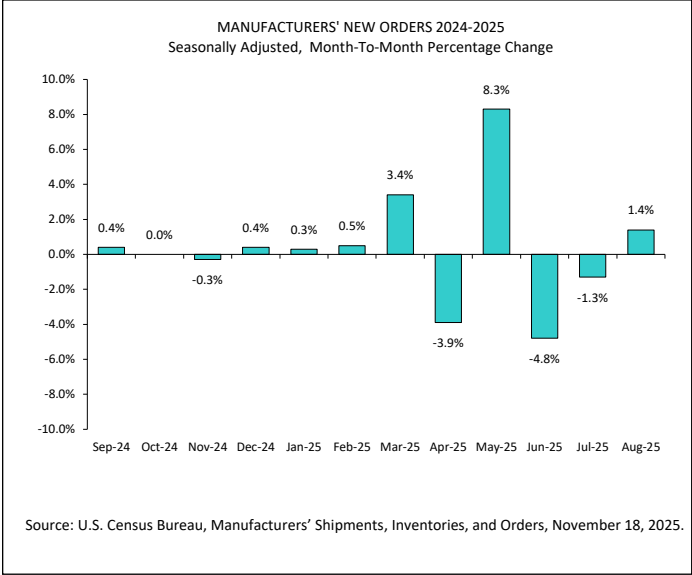
November 18, 2025 — The U.S. Census Bureau announces the August full report on manufacturers’ shipments, inventories and orders:

**MANUFACTURED GOODS – NEW ORDERS**

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in August, up following two consecutive monthly decreases, increased \$8.4 billion or 1.4 percent to \$612.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.3 percent July decrease. Shipments, down following three consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.1 percent to \$607.7 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent July increase. Unfilled orders, up thirteen of the last fourteen months, increased \$9.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$1,478.7 billion. This followed a virtually unchanged July increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.93, up from 6.86 in July. Inventories, up ten of the last eleven months, increased \$0.2 billion or virtually unchanged to \$948.4 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent July increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.56, unchanged from July.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in August, up following two consecutive monthly decreases, increased \$8.7 billion or 2.9 percent to \$311.8 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 2.8 percent July decrease. Transportation equipment, also up following two consecutive

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monthly decreases, led the increase, \$8.1 billion or 7.9 percent to \$110.2 billion. New orders for manufactured nondurable goods decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$300.3 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in August, down following eight consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$307.4 billion, unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a 1.5 percent July increase. Transportation equipment, down following four consecutive monthly increases, led the decrease, \$0.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$102.1 billion. Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, down following three consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$300.3 billion. This followed a 0.3 percent July increase. Petroleum and coal products, down following two consecutive monthly increases, drove the decrease, \$0.6 billion or 1.1 percent to \$54.7 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in August, up thirteen of the last fourteen months, increased \$9.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$1,478.7 billion, down from the previously published 0.7 percent increase. This followed a virtually unchanged July increase. Transportation equipment, up five of the last six months, led the increase, \$8.1 billion or 0.9 percent to \$919.1 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in August, up eleven consecutive months, increased less than \$0.1 billion or virtually unchanged to \$590.9 billion, up from the previously published virtually unchanged decrease. This followed a 0.3 percent July increase. Primary metals, up six consecutive months, drove the increase, \$0.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$48.1 billion. Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up three consecutive months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$357.6 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent July increase. Petroleum and coal products, also up three consecutive months, led the increase, \$0.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$44.4 billion. By stage of fabrication, August materials and supplies decreased 0.1 percent in durable goods and increased 0.2 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 0.3 percent in durable goods and 0.1 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.5 percent in durable goods and were virtually unchanged in nondurable goods.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing.

“Virtually unchanged” indicates that the change is less than 0.05 percent for a percent increase or decrease.

Description of the survey

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau’s Manufacturers’ Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 4,700 reporting units that represent approximately 3,000 companies and provide an indication of month-to-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 58 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2022 Economic Census, and these companies include roughly 52 percent of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2022 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data

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are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 38 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2022 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication. Not seasonally adjusted estimates of shipments and new orders include adjusted data for non-calendar reporters. Seasonally adjusted estimates include concurrent adjustments for holiday and trading-day differences, where appropriate, as well as seasonal variation, based on the results of the latest annual review of the model parameters. Estimates are not adjusted for price changes.² Estimates and percent changes of shipments for the semiconductor industry are included in computers and electronic products, and all other applicable aggregate totals.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated.
